The only accused in the trial of the attack at Magnanville expressed his compassion to the families of the victims at the opening of the hearing today before the circuit court of Paris. This Franco-Moroccan is on trial for complicity in terrorist assassinations after the murder of a police couple in July 2016 in their own home. The defendant is a childhood friend of the attacker who was shot dead by the raid at the time of the events. He risks life in prison.

A call for witnesses was launched in the Bas Rhin to try to find Lina. The 15-year-old girl has been missing since Saturday morning, when she was supposed to catch a train towards Strasbourg to join her boyfriend. It was her family who warned the authorities. The searches carried out this weekend resumed today and an investigation into a concerning disappearance has also been opened.

How can prices be reduced at the pump? Emmanuel Macron asked yesterday distributors to sell fuels at cost price. The subject will be at the heart of a meeting tomorrow in Matignon. Prime Minister Elisabeth Borne will receive distributors and professionals in the sector to try to move forward on this issue after the proposal to sell gasoline and diesel at a loss was refused.

And abroad, everything is done to try to avoid a blockage in the United States. However, this scenario seems more and more likely. The 2024 budget must be adopted by Congress before Sunday, but the debates are currently very tense. In the absence of an agreement between Democrats and Republicans, the federal administration will have to stop certain payments for civil servants. 2 million agents could be affected by the freezing of their salaries.
