Two 11th-grade students were arrested in their principal's office today in La Roche sur Yon in Vendée. The high school students are suspected of school harassment on a 10th-grade student. The police were not wearing uniforms as they arrested them both. Placed in police custody, the 16 and 17-year-old suspects are currently being questioned for acts of violence.

The search has ended in the Bas-Rhin. The citizen's search carried out to try to find Lina is now over. The 15-year-old teenager has been missing since Saturday, when she was supposed to take a train to Strasbourg, but the first elements of the investigation indicate that she never boarded.

And it took everyone by surprise. The head of the Leclerc brands will offer fuel at cost price every day. The measure will be effective from Friday in the group's 750 gas stations.
