Emmanuel Macron stated before the Corsican Assembly today that "Corsican autonomy must be neither against the State nor without the State". The Head of State also spoke out in favor of the entry of Corsica into the Constitution. But for Jean-Guy Talamoni, former president of the Corsican Assembly, Emmanuel Macron's position is far below the expectations of the autonomists.

The Corsica libera party also calls for the creation of a Corsican resident status, in particular to limit the rise in real estate prices.

After article 49.3 of the constitution used by Elisabeth Borne to have her public finance programming law adopted, the Nupes motion of censure will be examined tomorrow evening. The right will not table a motion. This is the twelfth time the government has used article 49.3 since the beginning of the mandate.

And another day of unsuccessful searches in the Bas-Rhin to try to find Lina, the 15-year-old teenager who has disappeared since Saturday. 80 gendarmes were mobilized today for new search operations, but these searches were once again unsuccessful.

In Spain, a fourteen-year-old student stabbed two teenagers and three teachers in a school in Andalusia. He also injured several other people before finally being arrested by the police. According to the Spanish press, he was supposedly the victim of mockery from his comrades.
