With the objective of strengthening the presence of law enforcement on the ground, Emmanuel Macron has just revealed the details of the establishment of more than 200 new gendarmerie brigades across the entire country by 2027. 238 new brigades exactly — which is more than what was planned. They will most often take the form of mobile trucks to act more easily in the most neglected areas. The Head of State will speak on the theme of security this evening on France 3.

The investigation into the disappearance of Lina in the Bas Rhine is suggesting a criminal act. A judicial investigation has been opened for kidnapping and sequestration. The 15-year-old teenager has been missing for more than a week. A witness also claims to have seen Lina in a car on the day of her disappearance.

The Nobel Prize in Medicine was awarded today to the Hungarian Katalin Kariko and the American Drew Weissman. The 2 researchers were rewarded for their discoveries on messenger RNA, which made it possible to develop vaccines against Covid-19.

And there has been a resumption of the epidemic these past weeks. the government has advanced the date of the new vaccination campaign by 2 weeks. It therefore begins today for people at risk, that is to say people aged 65 and over, those with comorbidities and pregnant women.

The vaccination campaign against papillomaviruses also starts today. This concerns 7th grade middle school students in certain regions. It was announced at the start of the year by Emmanuel Macron, to fight this disease responsible for 6,000 new cases of cancer every year in France. France is behind its European neighbors; the government is aiming for 80% of vaccinations for this age group by 2030.

And then after an abnormally hot month of September, the beginning of October also promises to be record-breaking. It was over 35 degrees today in the Pyrénées-Atlantiques, before a drop of temperatures tomorrow. Temperatures are then expected to rise again mid-week.
