2 days after the attack of the Hamas on Israel, numerous gatherings in support of the Hebrew country will take place this evening in France. There will be solidarity marches in Bordeaux, Toulouse, Strasbourg and Montpellier. In Paris the Crif, the Council representative of the Jewish institutions of France called to meet at 6:30 p.m. at Place Victor Hugo to then walk to Place du Trocadéro.

And as a sign of support, the Eiffel Tower and the National Assembly will be illuminated this evening with the colors of Israel, in blue and white.

On site, the conflict continues between Israel and the Hamas. Israeli forces bombed southern Lebanon this afternoon, where there were numerous armed terrorists according to the IDF. Israel also indicates having regained control of the localities attacked by the Hamas, but also the establishment of a complete siege on the Gaza Strip.

In the rest of the news, 10 days after the visit of Emmanuel Macron to Corsica and his proposal for "autonomy within the Republic", numerous attacks took place in the region last night. Around 20 homes exploded throughout the island. These were mostly secondary homes. The FLNC separatists claimed responsibility for these attacks today.

And Antoine Dupont, seriously injured in the cheekbone, is now able to resume training, only 2 weeks after his surgery. We do not yet know if he will play on Sunday in the quarter final of the World Cup against South Africa.
