"We are with them", said Elisabeth Borne at the National Assembly as she paid tribute this afternoon to the Israeli people, 3 days after the Hamas terrorist attack. In front of the Assembly, the Prime Minister defended the role of France which is to "always defend democracy", before qualifying Hamas as "a terrorist group". Attacking the Jewish community is attacking the entire Republic declared the head of government. Before she spoke, a minute of silence was observed by all the MPs, as a sign of support to Israel.

Before that, Emmanuel Macron strongly condemned the terrorist acts of the Hamas in Israel. The Fights have killed more than 900 people of the Hebrew State, including 4 French nationals. The Head of State, during a speech in Hamburg, suggested that help was provided to the Hamas to carry out its attack, referring to Iran. The Iranian Ayatollah denies any involvement of his country in these offensives.

The Hamas threatens to execute hostages for each new Israeli counterattack. Emmanuel Macron qualifies this as an "unbearable blackmail". We do not know if the 13 missing French nationals are among the prisoners.

In the rest of the news, life imprisonment, accompanied by a security sentence of 22 years was requested today against Mohamed Lamine Aberouz. He is accused of being the accomplice of the terrorist who murdered a couple of police officers at their home in Magnanville in 2016. The verdict will be communicated tomorrow.

And to finish, Stéphane Plaza is in trouble. The famous M6 television host is accused of violence by several of his ex-girlfriends. A rally to demand a boycott of his shows is being organized this evening at 7:30 in front of the M6 headquarters. The channel will broadcast this evening 2 documentaries dedicated to him. Stéphane Plaza denies these allegations.
