A teacher was killed in the city of Arras. Two other people are injured, one of which seriously following a knife attack at the Gambetta high school. It happened late in the morning. The assailant who shouted Allah Akbhar was arrested. The attacker is supposedly a young man in his twenties of Chechen origin and is "fiché S". He was supposedly a former student of the establishment. His brother was also arrested. Emmanuel Macron will be on site, as announced by the Élysée.

In the rest of the news: It's probably a matter of hours before the counterattack. Israel has just ordered the evacuation of northern Gaza and more than a million inhabitants - a sign that the counter-land offensive of the Hebrew state is taking shape, 6 days after the bloody Hamas attack.

No agreement was reached between the 27 member countries of the EU. They were unable to agree on whether or not to renew for 10 years the authorization of glyphosate. The herbicide is classified as a probable carcinogen by the World Health Organization. A new vote will be held in early November.

And then soccer: The French team may qualify for the 2024 Euro this evening. *Les Bleus* will be in the Netherlands. A victory is enough for the men of Didier Deschamps to validate their qualification.
