Emmanuel Macron supports the teaching profession. The Head of State spoke after the attack committed in a high school in Arras, where a teacher was stabbed to death and two other people seriously injured. The teacher "first intervened and surely saved a lot of lives", said the President in his tribute, highlighting his courage and that of all the staff of the establishment. The alleged assailant is a 20-year-old man from Chechnya. He was arrested along with his youngest brother. His older brother is currently in prison. This former student of the establishment is said to have shouted Allah Akbar just before taking action. "Fiché S", he was monitored by the DGSI. The National Anti-Terrorism Prosecutor's Office has taken up the investigation. Emmanuel Macron is currently chairing a security meeting at the Elysée.

During his speech, the Head of State also mentioned an "attempted attack" foiled today. It is in reality an arrest in Limay, in Yvelines. According to the national anti-terrorism prosecutor's office, a "man, carrying a knife", was arrested "as he was leaving a prayer room located near a high school". An investigation is underway.

In the Middle East, Israel orders the evacuation of "all civilians" from Gaza City to the south of the Palestinian enclave. The massive bombings launched in response to the Hamas attack resulted in 1,537 deaths, including 500 children, according to the latest report from local authorities.

Also in the news today: The mobilization against inflation in France. Around 20,000 people took to the streets today in Paris as part of the inter-union day of action on wages. The CGT counts 200,000 demonstrators throughout the country. The police have not yet communicated their figures.
