Lots of emotion this morning in Arras at the funeral of Dominique Bernard. The French teacher was killed in his high school almost a week ago, by a radicalized 20-year-old man. Emmanuel Macron and the Minister of National Education, Gabriel Attal attended the ceremony at the Arras Cathedral. The speeches of the victim's relatives followed one another. His wife, his daughters as well as a former colleague, Aurélie, paid tribute to the teacher.

And more than 400 people also gathered outside the cathedral to honor the memory of Dominique Bernard.

New bomb threats occurred today in airports but also in high schools. The Château de Versailles had to close a good part of the afternoon. This is the fourth time this has happened since last Saturday. The Minister of Justice Éric Dupond-Moretti promises that the authors of these bomb threats will be found and punished.

A tragedy took place in the Ardennes, where the body of a ten-year-old girl was found yesterday evening in the cellar of a building in Sedan. The child had been missing since the day before. A man was arrested and placed in police custody.

28 French people were killed in the Hamas attack on October 7 in Israel, according to the latest report from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. 7 French nationals are still missing. Some of them were taken hostage, says the Quai d'Orsay.

And then the Alpes-Maritimes will be placed under red alert for rain and flooding for tomorrow night. Météo France warns of a particularly intense rainy episode and calls for caution. This evening the department is under orange alert for floods. 7 other departments in the eastern half are in orange for wind, flood or rain.
