13 days after war broke out between Israel and Hamas, the first humanitarian convoy is due to arrive today in the Gaza Strip. It will pass through Egypt and the Rafa border crossing point in order to bring much needed water, food and medicine to the people of Gaza.

In France, Gabriel Attal wants to remove students from schools if they have been flagged for radicalisation. The Minister of Education spoke last night on the programme "L'événement" on channel France 2, a week after a teacher was killed at work in Arras. Attal claims there are currently several dozen minors across the country who constitute "a danger" or "a threat".

Yesterday saw a second day of evacuation in French airports, with at least 11 bomb alerts issued. There were also alerts in schools, bringing the total number for Thursday to 75. According to the Minister of the Interior, Gérald Darmanin, 18 people, who were mainly minors, were arrested over the past 48 hours.

The body found in a house in the Rhône has been confirmed as that of Marwan Berreni. The actor from the soap "Plus belle la vie" had been missing for two months. He is suspected of having hit a 37-year-old woman with his car in Saône et Loire. Investigations are continuing to determine the exact causes of death.

And finally, tonight is the first of the semi-finals in the Rugby World Cup, with Argentina against New Zealand kicking off at 9 p.m. at the Stade de France. Tomorrow evening South Africa will face England.
