"We are bound to Israel through mourning". These are the words of Emmanuel Macron this morning. The Head of State is currently in the Hebrew State where he met this morning with the families of the victims. The French president announced that 9 French nationals were missing or held hostage by Hamas. He is currently speaking with Israeli Prime Minister Benyamin Nethanyahu as the bombings intensify. For Patrick Martin Genier, teacher at science po and specialist in international issues, the head of state must be particularly vigilant during his trip.

Emmanuel Macron will soon travel to the West Bank to meet the President of the Palestinian Authority Mahmoud Abbas.

Also in the news, 2 men, suspected of being involved in the terrorist attack last week in Brussels are indicted and imprisoned in Paris. The 2 Tunisian nationals, who live in the Paris region, are said to have a link with the attack during which 2 Swedish fans, who came to see the Belgium-Sweden soccer match, were killed.

The technical inspection of two-wheelers will be gradually implemented from next April in France. The decree to this effect was published today in the Official Journal. The first vehicles which will be affected are those registered before January 1st 2017. The measure had until now been postponed several times by the government.
