Emmanuel Macron has made the release of all those held hostage by the Hamas his priority. In Israel, the Head of State spoke at midday with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and during a speech, the President stated that 30 French people were killed by the Palestinian Islamic movement, and that 9 other nationals are being held prisoner. Faced with this, Emmanuel Macron wanted to reiterate all his support for Israel and promises a coalition to fight terrorism.

Emmanuel Macron then arrived late in the afternoon in Ramallah, in the West Bank, where he spoke with the President of the Palestinian Authority Mahmoud Abbas about the conflict between Israel and Hamas.

In the rest of the news: The fight against school bullying.
