The number of French people killed by Hamas continues to rise: 31 French nationals died in the attacks according to the latest report. Nine other nationals are still missing or taken hostage. This was announced this afternoon by Emmanuel Macron from Egypt. After meeting with his Egyptian counterpart Abdel Fattah al-Sissi, in Cairo, the French president stressed the importance of a resumption of political dialogue to obtain lasting peace.

The Head of State also announced the dispatch of a national navy ship to support hospitals in Gaza. It will leave Toulon within the next 48 hours. Furthermore, a French plane will land tomorrow on Egyptian soil to deliver medical equipment.

In Corrèze, a reconstruction was organized today in the case of the murder of Justine Vayrac. The body of the 20-year-old woman was found buried in a hamlet a year ago after having spent the evening in a nightclub of Brive. It was the alleged murderer who told investigators where the body was.

And this is a first in three years: There is a slight increase in unemployment in France. A 0.6% increase was noted in the third quarter. Over one year, on the other hand, the number of job seekers without any activity fell by almost 4%.

And then there's soccer this evening with the 3rd day of the Champions League. After its big defeat against Newcastle, the PSG must do better this evening against AC Milan at the Parc des Princes. Kick-off at 9 p.m.
