Emmanuel Macron is in Brussels. The Head of State and his European counterparts are trying to find a common response to the catastrophic humanitarian situation in Gaza. Dozens of hospitals have stopped functioning, due to lack of electricity and medicine. The population lacks water and food. The Europeans have launched a joint appeal for a break in the fighting so that humanitarian aid can arrive on site. France will, for its part, send 54 tons of emergency aid tomorrow.

The dissolution of the ecological collective *Le Soulèvement de la Terre* is again before the Council of State this Friday. Seized in August by a summary judgment, the body suspended the dissolution decree in view of a "serious doubt" about the reasons given by the executive to dissolve the movement. A support rally is planned.

In the United States, the manhunt continues in Maine. A man opened fire in a bowling alley and restaurant Wednesday evening, killing 18 people. Residents are called to remain confined in their homes until the shooter has been found. The killer is an army reservist and firearm instructor.
