Emmanuel Macron calls for a humanitarian truce in the Gaza Strip. On the sidelines of a European summit in Brussels, the head of state asked to protect the populations. Furthermore, he hopes to evacuate as soon as possible the 170 French nationals present on site.

And the Israeli army carried out a new ground incursion last night. Hamas weapons and men were neutralized. According to the UN, around half of the homes in the Gaza Strip were damaged since the start of the conflict on October 7. The United Nations is warning of the humanitarian situation there, where medicine and food are in short supply.

Eight people will be tried next year in the case of the assassination of Samuel Paty. The trial will take place before in court at the end of 2024. Two friends of the assailant are suspected of having had precise knowledge of the terrorist project. In addition, six minors will also be tried, behind closed doors, before the juvenile court starting next month.

Elisabeth Borne presented her social measures for working-class neighborhoods in response to the riots at the beginning of the summer. The government will ask prefects to no longer allocate housing in priority neighborhoods to households in great difficulty. The goal is to promote social diversity. Another announcement was the "Quartiers 2030" program, which will be extended. It aims at supporting entrepreneurs from working-class neighborhoods in carrying out their professional projects.

One week after the passage of storm Aline, the Alpes-Maritimes released 15 million euros, as the valleys of the Nice hinterland suffered heavy material damage. Decrees were signed to recognize the urgency of carrying out reconstruction work. A Reconstruction Council must also be created by the end of November.

And then rugby with the small final of the World Cup this evening. Argentina will face England. This is the opportunity for Argentina to take their revenge after their defeat in the group match against the English. Kickoff at 9 p.m. at the Stade de France. Tomorrow evening the grand finale of this World Cup will put New Zealand against South Africa.
