Both the Olympique Lyonnais and the Olympique de Marseille announced they were filing a complaint after the violence that occurred last night before the match between Marseille and Lyon at the end of the 10th day of Premier League. The bus Olympique Lyonnais was stoned early in the evening before arriving at the stadium. Coach Fabio Grosso was seriously injured in the face and the match was postponed. And the Olympique Lyonnais added that it strongly condemned the racist gestures of its supporters.

Also in the news, the number of anti-Semitic acts continues to rise with 819 acts reported in France since October 7 and the Hamas attack on Israel. This was announced this morning by Gérald Darmanin on BFM TV. The Minister of the Interior also mentioned that 414 people were arrested.

Regarding the conflict, Israel intensifies its offensive on the Gaza Strip. The Israeli army carried out new retaliatory strikes on this Palestinian enclave overnight, 3 weeks after the Hamas attack on the Hebrew State. Israel claims to have struck 600 targets in the last 24 hours.

An investigation has been opened following yesterday's tragedy in Vémar in the Val d'Oise: A gendarme killed his three daughters aged between 5 and 10 before committing suicide. this tragedy supposedly occurred in a complicated family context according to the Pontoise public prosecutor's office. The bodies were found by two colleagues of the soldier. The mother of the three girls, in a state of shock, was taken care of by the emergency services.
