The storm is approaching. From tomorrow, rain and strong gusts of wind are expected in the West and more particularly in Brittany. Météo France has also placed, for tomorrow, the Côtes-d'Armor, Finistère and Morbihan under orange alert for violent wind. 24 hours before the phenomenon, the town of Douarnenez in Finistère took measures to secure buildings and public roads. For the town mayor Jocelyne Poitevin, anticipating risks also means preparing the population.

As a consequences of the passage of this storm, the SNCF has decided to completely interrupt TER traffic for safety reasons in 5 regions: Brittany, Hauts-de-France, Centre-Val de Loire, Normandy and the Pays de la Loire. And this from tomorrow evening until Friday morning.

This is a phenomenon that has been increasing these past days, more precisely since the Hamas terrorist attack on Israel 3 weeks ago: More than 800 anti-Semitic acts have been reported in France. This weekend several dozen Stars of David were tagged on homes in Paris. The town hall announces filing a complaint. An investigation has been opened.

And to finish, tennis: Ugo Humbert qualifies for the 2nd round of the Rolex Paris Masters. He beat the American Marcos Giron in 2 sets. On the other hand, it's over for Arthur Fils and Benjamin Bonzi, eliminated in the first round. Gael Monfils will enter the running this evening.
