Only 12 departments are left under orange alert. After hitting the west, the storm is shifting north. The Somme, Pas-de-Calais and the North are under weather alert. The prefecture of the Hauts-de-France calls for caution and asks to limit travel as much as possible. In the southern half, the Landes, the Pyrénées-Atlantiques, but also the Bouches-du -Rhône, Var, Alpes-Maritimes and southern Corsica are under orange alert for wave submersion.

As for the storm's repercussions, a second death has been reported. That of a 70-year-old man, in Le Havre. He apparently fell due to a gust of wind as he was closing his shutters. The other victim is a truck driver who was killed last night in the Aisne. 16 people were also injured, including one seriously.

In Lyon, the regional council offices were evacuated at the beginning of the afternoon after receiving a threatening email. Several hundreds of agents had to leave the premises. The bomb squad went on site for inspection.

Caregivers want to defend state medical aid. 3,000 of them have signed a column published this evening in *Le Monde*, in which they ask to renounce any project affecting or restricting the scope of this system. A system which allows illegal foreigners present in France for at least three months to benefit from full coverage of their health costs.

Egypt will help with the evacuation of around 7,000 foreigners from the Gaza Strip. More than 60 nationalities are represented according to the Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs. Yesterday the Rafah crossing point opened its doors to the evacuation of dozens of injured Palestinians and hundreds of foreign passport holders including five French nationals.
