Pas de Calais is placed under red alert for risk of flooding. The level of the Aa river is exceptionally high after the passage of the storms. The neighboring department of the North is placed under orange alert for rain and flooding and 5 other departments of Nouvelle Aquitaine are also under orange alert for risk of flooding.

Gérald Darmanin was before the Senate this afternoon. The Minister of the Interior is currently defending the government's Immigration Bill which plans to expel "delinquent" foreigners as a priority and legalize the situation of undocumented workers in professions under pressure. The objective for him was to convince the right, majority in the upper house, before the text is examined in the Assembly.

"This trial is an infamy", said this afternoon Eric Dupond-Moretti at the bar of the Court of Justice of the Republic. The Keeper of the Seals is on trial since today for suspicion of "illegal taking of interest "- A first for a minister in office. He is accused of having used his power in government to settle scores with magistrates. During the 2 weeks of hearing, Eric Dupont Moretti will continue to exercise his functions of Keeper of the Seals.

The 4 schoolchildren, prosecuted in the case of the death of the young Lucas were acquitted today by the Court of Appeal of Nancy. They were accused of having harassed the 13-year-old teenager, which led to the suicide of the young boy last January in the Vosges. The judges pointed out "the lack of demonstrated effect" of the defendants' offensive comments "on Lucas' mental health".

And fuel prices continue to fluctuate. The liter of gasoline increased slightly by 1.4 cents last week. On the other hand, the Ministry of Ecological Transition announced today that the price of a liter of diesel fell by 8 cents.

And then it's the first prize of the literary season: The Femina was awarded today to Neige Sinno, for her book "Sad Tiger". A story about the incest she suffered herself during her childhood. Tomorrow we will know the winners of the Prix Goncourt and that of the Renaudot.
