The inhabitants of Pas-de-Calais are still in the water, after spectacular floods and heavy rainfall. The Canche River has just been placed under red alert, as well as the Liane and the Aa. Exceptional flooding is expected from 2 p.m.; the department will also be placed under red alert, this time for Rain and Flooding.

The department of Somme has been placed under orange alert for rain and flooding as well, and therefore joins the North and Seine-Maritime. Charente-Maritime remains under orange alert.

In the rest of the news, the government wants to put an end to bullying in schools for good. This was stated by the Head of State this morning during his opening speech of the humanitarian conference for the civilian population of Gaza. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu reiterated yesterday that there will be no ceasefire until the hostages held by Hamas have been released.
