200 schools in Pas-de-Calais are closed until the end of the week due to the weather conditions. The department is under red alert for rain and flooding. Local residents are preparing to experience a night of torrential rain. Minister of the Interior Gérald Darmanin calls for the greatest caution. Four departments are under orange alert, the North, the Somme, Seine-Maritime and Charente-Maritime.

Elisabeth Borne calls for a collective wake-up call on the issue of school bullying. The Prime Minister called on adults not to minimize what children experience. In this context, a questionnaire is being distributed from today to students, from CE2 to Terminale, to talk about this issue.

The Council of State cancels the decree dissolving the *Soulèvement de la Terre*. Gérald Darmanin initiated the procedure targeting the environmentalist collective a few days after the violent clashes between gendarmes and opponents of the mega-basins in Sainte-Soline. As for the Council of State, it considers that no provocation to violence can be attributed to the group.

A man was arrested and placed in police custody in Montpellier, as he is accused of the murder of his wife. The victim was stabbed around twenty times. When the police arrived, he was threatening to jump out of the window from the sixth floor. He had already been implicated last summer for death threats against his wife.

It's a record, at just 17 years old, Warren Zaire-Emery is called up for the French national team for the first time. Didier Deschamps selected him for the 2024 Euro qualifying matches against Gibraltar and Greece, in ten days. Warren Zaire-Emery, PSG player, is already captain of the team France Espoirs.

And then in tennis, France is officially eliminated from the Billie Jean King Cup. Julien Benneteau's players, beaten yesterday by Italy, will not see the rest of the competition after the Italians' new victory today against Germany..
