Pas-de-Calais remains under red alert for floods and rain, although last night's precipitation was less than expected. The firefighters intervened around fifty times, especially for evacuations. Around twenty residents of a retirement home in Nielles-les-Bléquin were evacuated, as the establishment was threatened by a beginning of flooding. TER circulation is interrupted until tomorrow on several axes, notably "Boulogne-Etaples". In total, more than 200 schools are closed today in the department.

And it's not just the Pas-de-Calais which is under alert: The North, Somme, Seine-Maritime and Charente-Maritime are under orange alert as well. Météo France calls for caution.

The images of the Hamas attack on October 7 in Israel will be broadcast to the National Assembly next Tuesday. This is an initiative of the president of the France/Israel friendship group, Mathieu Lefèvre. Unbearable images, but which according to the MP must be seen to become aware of the barbarity and not forget it. MPs from all sides should participate in this screening.

In Israel, the army agrees to observe breaks of 4 to 6 hours each day in the north of the Gaza Strip, to allow Palestinian civilians to leave the area. These breaks will be announced three hours in advance. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu reaffirmed his goal of eradicating the Hamas.

As temperatures cool, Sanofi assures that there is no risk of a shortage of Doliprane for this winter. Factories are running 24 hours a day to avoid pressure on stocks. The pharmaceutical company nonetheless calls on the French not to overstock.

And the United States approves the first vaccine against chikungunya - This disease transmitted to humans by infected mosquitoes, causing fever and joint pain. This vaccine is only authorized so far for adults at increased risk of being exposed to the virus.
