Pas-de-Calais remains under alert. After the bad weather, the Civil Protection of Pas-de-Calais is launching a call for donations. They will be used to finance the equipment necessary to clear and clean houses. More than 200 schools are still closed. Three other departments are also under alert: the North, Vendée and Charente-Maritime.

The government will be devoting 230 million euros to help departments. This was announced by Elisabeth Borne at the Assises des Départements de France, in Strasbourg. The sum will be used to finance expenditure in matters of child protection and assistance for the autonomy of the elderly.

As gatherings against anti-Semitism are planned for Sunday in France, there has been an attack in the Var at Six-Fours-les-Plages. A woman was slapped and threatened as she was walking home Wednesday evening. The attacker hurled anti-Semitic insults at her while promising to kill her the next time he saw her. He is wanted by the police.

The UN agency for Palestinian refugees calls for an end to the fighting in Gaza and speaks of a carnage. For its part, the Israeli army has agreed to observe pauses of 4 to 6 hours every day in the north of the Gaza Strip to allow civilians to flee.

And a high school in Lyon was targeted by mortar fire. The scene took place this morning in the 8th arrondissement, when a dozen people targeted the La Martinière – Monplaisir high school, without causing any injuries. The group is said to have targeted the principal of the establishment present behind the gates. Two people were arrested, one of them believed to be a student at the high school.

And then soccer this evening with the start of the 12th day of Premier League. Montpellier receives the leader, Nice at 9 p.m.
