Humanitarian operations will end in Gaza within 48 hours. This is the warning issued this evening by the UN. The reason being that no fuel is allowed to enter the city, which is currently under the bombings of the Israeli army.

The President of the National Assembly Yaël Braun Pivet spoke about the gatherings yesterday throughout France against anti-Semitism at the initiative of the event with the President of the Senate Gérard Larcher, she was pleased that the French had responded to the call and said that these gatherings were a popular success. Yael Braun Pivet also defended the absence of Emmanuel Macron.

Emmanuel Macron who received this morning at the Elysée the representatives of the different religions. At the end of this meeting, the chief rabbi of France spoke of an incredible dignity regarding the gatherings which took place yesterday. As for the rector of the Grand Mosque of Paris, he declared that anti-Semitism would not pass through mosques.

In the rest of the news, Pas de Calais is still under orange alert. Heavy rains are expected with a possible new rise in water levels and risks of flooding. The department is barely recovering from the floods of these past few days which have caused great damage.
