It was a long-awaited decision: Glyphosate will be reauthorized for 10 years within the European Union.

The 27 member states have not managed to find an agreement today on whether or not to extend this very controversial herbicide. Obviously, this decision is a disappointment for many.

As a reminder, this herbicide is considered carcinogenic by the World Health Organization.

In Gaza, the Israeli army continues today its targeted military operation against Hamas in the Al Chifa hospital. Israel accuses the Palestinian Islamist movement of using the establishment as a military base. A raid is currently being carried out by the Hebrew State despite the presence of hundreds of patients and thousands of civilians.
