Over 11,000 elected officials have gathered at Porte de Versailles in Paris for the opening today of the 105th Congress of Mayors of France which will take place until Thursday. This year, the question of violence against mayors will be at the heart of discussions. In 1 year, attacks on elected officials have increased by 15% according to the Ministry of the Interior.

Emmanuel Macron deplores the numerous deaths of civilians in Gaza. The Head of State called on Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to distinguish terrorists from the population. To help the civilians of Gaza, France will send a 4th plane this week with 10 tons of medical cargo; injured or sick children can also be treated in French hospitals.

The case of Pierre Palmade is in court. Not the actor himself, but the comedian's dealers are being tried for drug trafficking from today. The trial will have to determine whether the 3 suspects have delivered the drugs consumed by Pierre Palmade on the day of his accident, which resulted in 3 people being seriously injured last February on a road in Seine-et-Marne.

Be careful if you have to fly today. Air traffic is disrupted due to a strike by air traffic controllers. A quarter of flights are canceled from Paris-Orly and Toulouse-Blagnac airports and 20% of flights from Bordeaux-Mérignac and Marseille-Provence are cancelled as well.

In Mayotte, water reserves are running out while the territory is affected by an unprecedented drought. The department is currently deprived of running water more than 2 days out of 3. Faced with this, bottled water will be distributed to the entire population from today. A total of 330,000 liters will be provided every day, which amounts to one liter per person, daily.

And he is the new face of Argentina: Javier Milei was elected President yesterday with 55% of votes. Climatesceptic, anti-abortion and pro-guns, he is nicknamed the "Trump of the Pampas".

And then in soccer, the Rennes stadium will present its new coach this afternoon after the departure of Bruno Genesio. It is Julien Stephan, a regular at the Breton club since he had already coached Rennes between 2019 and 2021, where he had won the Coupe de France 4 years ago.
