The main suspect in the death of Thomas this weekend in Drôme is said to be one of the 7 people arrested today as part of the investigation. As a reminder, a 16-year-old teenager was killed and 8 people were injured during a village festival on Saturday evening in Crépol in the Drôme. A group of individuals burst into the room before attacking the participants with a knife. A solemn march will be organized tomorrow in Roman sur Isère, where the victim went to school.

The *Restos du coeur* launches its winter campaign. The association started today its major national collection to help the most vulnerable. More than two months after its president's call for help, the situation remains very tense. Due to inflation and the increase in requests, 5 to 10% of last year's beneficiaries will not have access to aid this year.

Farmers from Metz, Thionville and Colmar today, before Toulouse tomorrow are mobilizing throughout France. Actions have been carried out in front of prefectures and in supermarkets to challenge public authorities in the face of ever lower prices and ever-increasing administrative constraints.

Abroad, discussions are accelerating for the release of hostages held since October 7 by Hamas in the Gaza Strip. Negotiations between the Palestinian movement and Israel are entering their final phase. They have never been so close to succeeding according to Qatar - one of the mediators in this matter with the United States and Egypt.

And then only one department remains under orange weather alert this evening for risk of flooding and that is the Pas de Calais.

Rain is expected in the area which is barely recovering from the recent flooding. 1000 firefighters remain mobilized on site.
