It's only a matter of hours: The release of some of the hostages held by Hamas will begin tomorrow. This was confirmed by Qatar - one of the mediators in the negotiations between the Palestinian movement and Israel. The Jewish State has received a first list with the names of the 13 people, mainly women and children, who will be released. In return, Israel undertakes to respect a military truce of 4 days starting tomorrow morning and to release 50 Palestinian prisoners.

In Ireland, there was a knife attack near a school in Dublin. 5 people including 3 children were injured. The victims were transported to the hospital and the main suspect was arrested; for now, we do not know the reasons for this attack.

Also in the news in France: Searches took place today in Romans-sur-Isère, 5 days after the death of young Thomas in Crépol in Drome. The 16-year-old teenager was killed during a village festival last weekend. In this case, 9 people were arrested and placed in police custody for organized murder and attempted murder. Among the suspects is the alleged author of the stabbing - a young 20-year-old man. A vigil is planned this evening in the church of Crépol in memory of the victim. His funeral will take place tomorrow.

And Gabriel Matzneff is once again suspected of rape. This time it is the daughter of one of his close friends who accuses the writer. The events allegedly occurred in the 80s when the young woman was a child, so the time limit has now expired, but the alleged victim wishes to be heard as part of the investigation which was opened by the prosecution.

And then soccer and a hard blow for the PSG. The captain of the Parisian club Marquinhos will not participate in the next Champions League match. Paris receives Newcastle on Tuesday evening. The Brazilian defender suffers from an injury to his right thigh after a shock during the match against Argentina two days ago.
