Families are waiting for the Israeli hostages. The truce between Israel and Hamas came into force this morning and should result in the release of a total of 50 hostages kidnapped by the Palestinian group on October 7. 13 must be released this afternoon at 3 p.m. French time. An operation made particularly complicated by the military and geographical context.

In return, Israeli authorities have committed to releasing 150 Palestinians from prison. 24 women and 15 teenagers must be brought back to the West Bank today.

In the rest of the news, a final tribute to Thomas is taking place today. The funeral of the 16-year-old teenager killed last weekend during a village festival took place this morning in Drome, in the church of Saint-Donat-sur-l'Herbasse. More than 800 people attended the ceremony. As for the investigation, 9 people were arrested including the alleged perpetrator of the fatal stabbing.

Emmanuel Macron is in the Jura. The Head of State is expected this afternoon as part of the program "1 jeune 1 arbre". The president must participate in the replanting of a municipal forest with middle school students. The objective is to plant a billion trees in France within 10 years.

And there's soccer this evening with a great match to open the 13th day of Premier League: PSG receives Monaco. The leader faces the 3rd in the championship. Kick-off at 9 p.m.

And then the bad weather persists in the North. The department is placed under orange alert by the French weather forecast for a risk of wave submersion. An alert which must begin this evening at 8 p.m.
