The first hostages held by Hamas were released this afternoon. 13 people were entrusted to the Red Cross which must transport them to the Rafah border post. They will then be transferred to two hospitals in the suburbs of Tel-Aviv. In return, Israel has been observing a 4-day military truce in the Gaza Strip since this morning. The Hebrew state must also release 150 Palestinian prisoners.

In France, a final tribute was paid to Thomas. The funeral of the 16-year-old teenager killed last weekend during a village festival took place this morning in Drome, in the church of Saint -Donat-sur-l'Herbasse. More than 2000 people attended the ceremony. Regarding the investigation, 9 people were arrested and placed in police custody, including the alleged perpetrator of the fatal stabbing.

And the requisitions were presented at the trial of the disappeared of Mirepoix. The prosecuting attorney of the court of Foix en Ariège requested very heavy sentences against the two accused: A life sentence against Marie-José Montesinos and 30 years against Jean-Paul Vidal. The two former lovers are on trial for the murder of a father and his daughter in 2017. The verdict is expected this evening.
