The death of Thomas has shaken the entire country. The government spokesperson Olivier Véran was on site this morning, to pay tribute to the young boy.

In this case, 9 suspects were indicted, 6 of them including 2 minors are now placed in pre-trial detention. The 3 others are under judicial supervision.

Also in the news, a first trial is beginning in relation to the death of Samuel Paty. 3 years after the assassination of the professor of history and geography in Conflans Sainte Honorine, 6 minors are on trial from today before the Paris children's court. 5 of them are accused of having designated the teacher to the attacker in exchange for money.

Are we heading towards an extension of the truce between Israel and Hamas? Negotiations are underway as the last group of Israeli hostages are to be released today as part of the agreement reached last week between the two parties. The fighting is therefore expected to resume this evening, that is unless the Hamas releases more prisoners, in which case it would be 10 hostages for an additional day of truce.

After France, Belgium is affected in turn, with around thirty schools were victims of false bomb threats yesterday and also ransom demands by email. As a security measure, the schools will remain closed today. Around 10,000 students cannot go to school.

And then it continues to rain in the Pas de Calais. The department remains placed under orange alert for risk of flooding: The Canche and the Hème are particularly monitored.
