A new shooting took place in the Moulins neighborhood of Nice yesterday evening. As a result, two people are injured, one of which is in critical condition. The victims are 17 and 20 years old. In response, the CRS8 gendarmerie brigade specialized in urban violence will be sent on site. Their objective is to fight settling of scores against a backdrop of drug trafficking which has increased in recent weeks in this working-class neighborhood.

"I regret everything that happened", said Monique Olivier on the first day of her trial before the court of Hauts de Seine. The ex-wife of Michel Fourniret is on trial for complicity in the disappearances of Marie-Angèle Domèce, Joanna Parrish and Estelle Mouzin. After the death of the serial killer in 2021, she is now appearing alone. Her trial will last 3 weeks and Monique Olivier is now 75 years old and faces life in prison.

The controversial influencer Poupette Kenza is fined 50,000 euros. The young woman iss prosecuted for having promoted an illegal teeth-whitening product, without indicating the commercial nature of the publication on her social networks. She was the subject of a fraud repression investigation.

Also in the news, smoking will soon cost more. A pack of cigarettes will be sold for 12 euros in 2025 and 13 euros in 2026. This is one of the announcements of the plan to fight smoking revealed today by the Minister of Health Aurélien Rousseau.

And French fishermen will be able to benefit from the extension of aid of 20 cents per liter of fuel until June 2024. The confirmation came from Emmanuel Macron this afternoon from the *Assises de la mer* in Nantes. The Head of State also announced a call for tenders for an offshore wind farm in 2025. It should produce the annual electricity consumption of 10 million homes.

We will end with this great first in the sector of air transportation. The British company Virgin Atlantic has carried out a transatlantic flight using renewable kerosene - A fuel produced from used oil, wood residue and even algae. The plane left London just now and is due to land in New York this evening.
