The motivation mentioned by the man arrested after the knife attack in Paris on Saturday evening, is an attack in “reaction to the persecution of Muslims around the world”. As a reminder, a tourist has died, and two other people were injured. The radicalized suspect, “fiche S” also suffers from psychiatric disorders. His treatment was interrupted following medical advice.

Concern is growing in Aude, where a 16-year-old girl has been missing since Friday. Salomé did not return home after her classes at the Germaine Tillion high school in Castelnaudary. Her cell phone is turned off. The gendarmerie has launched a call for witnesses to try to find her.

The Social Security budget is definitively adopted after the rejection this morning of a final motion of censure submitted by the left. Prime Minister Élisabeth Borne once again used article 49.3 of the constitution on Friday to pass this text without a vote.

"I contest with all my strength the crimes of which I am accused", said Nicolas Zepeda at the opening of his second trial. The 32-year-old Chilean is retried for 3 weeks before the Court of Vesoul for the murder of Narumi. His ex-girlfriend disappeared 7 years ago in Besançon. The body of the Japanese student was never found. At first instance, Nicolas Zepeda was sentenced to 28 years in prison.

Michel Sardou tested positive for COVID. His concerts scheduled for tomorrow and Wednesday at the Zénith in Clermont-Ferrand are canceled. The 76-year-old singer had already postponed his Saturday evening performance in Brest for health reasons.
