The alleged assailant of the attack in Paris which left one dead and two injured on Saturday evening will come before the anti-terrorist justice authorities today. While in police custody, the 26-year-old French-Iranian individual, who was known to be radicalised and suffering from psychiatric disorders, took responsibility for his actions. A 27-year-old woman related to the suspect who is also known to be radicalised, was released from police custody during the night.

Two months after the Hamas attack on Israel, the IDF continues its offensive in the Gaza Strip. The Israeli army has stepped up fighting on the ground in the town of Khan Younès in the south Palestine. The UN fears a "hellish scenario" for the population. In total, more than 16,000 people have been killed in Gaza according to Hamas.

2023 has been the hottest year ever recorded, according to the Copernicus observatory. 2023 beat the year 2016, which previously held the heat record, by 0.13°C. The month of November also became the 6th consecutive month to beat temperature records. Scientists are urging action to be taken, and quickly, while the COP 28 climate summit is ongoing in Dubai.
