It has been 2 months, to the day, since the Hamas attacked Israel. Since then, the IDF has been waging fierce battles against the Islamist movement in the Gaza Strip, particularly to the south of the enclave in Rann Younès. The Israeli army claims to have "pierced the defensive lines" of Hamas, "eliminated numerous terrorists" and destroyed around "30 tunnel entrances".

The terrorist of the attack in Paris is placed in pre-trial detention and in solitary confinement after his attack on Saturday evening. He was indicted for assassination in relationship with a terrorist organization. While in police custody, the 26-year-old Franco-Iranian man indicated that his initial target was the Vel d'Hiv children's memorial garden.

Clément Beaune wants to make train travel an affordable and popular means of transportation. He said this morning that there will be no increase in prices at the SNCF. The Minister of Transport announces the freezing of prices for SNCF Ouigo and Intercités trains in 2024 to help travelers, in the midst of inflation.

The large distribution company, in great financial difficulty, is preparing to sell its stores, likely to Intermarché.
