A Hanouka celebration like no other. As anti-Semitic acts are surging in France, the Jewish community of France is celebrating the festival of lights under high security. The Minister of the Interior Gerald Darmanin called on the prefects to be on alert. The representative council of Jewish institutions in France is on alert as well.

Gérald Darmanin asks the police for a reinforced presence at the arrival and departure times of the faithful, during gatherings and services.

Emmanuel Macron receives Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban this evening. The objective is to convince him to lift his veto on two major European decisions in favor of Ukraine: The opening of negotiations around Kiev's accession to the European Union and the support plan of 50 billion euros to help Ukraine against Russia.

Elisabeth Borne will be in Mayotte tomorrow. The Prime Minister will spend the day on the island. Initially focused on education, this day will resemble more of a crisis visit due to the health situation on site. Since this summer, the water is regularly cut off or declared non-drinkable.

And then in soccer: the Italian anti-doping authority requests a 4-year suspension against Paul Pogba. Since this summer the Frenchman has been suspended after a positive test for testosterone.
