Discussions were tense this afternoon at the Assembly. The day after the rejection of the immigration bill, the session of questions to the government turned into a settling of scores this afternoon between the MPs of the opposition and the executive. "Our Assembly formally sanctioned the unbearable contempt of the Minister of the Interior", declared the leader of the Republicains Eric Ciotti.
