An electric car for 100 euros per month. Emmanuel Macron announced today the launch of the "My electric leasing" system from January 1st. A system provided for in the latest presidential program of the Head of State and which is aimed at the lowest 50% of household incomes. Those whose reference income is less than 15,400 euros per share and per year. There will be a gradual entry into force.
