Emmanuel Macron calls for an intelligent compromise on the immigration bill, in a speech given by the Head of State after a European summit. He wants the text on immigration to be at the service of the general interest and denounces the refusal of dialogue displayed by the opposition. Emmanuel Macron refuses to resort to article 49.3 of the constitution. While waiting for the joint committee that will take place on Monday, negotiations continue with the Republicans.

An investigation has been opened in Marseille after the discovery of the body of Mélody. The 34-year-old mother had been missing for more than a month after leaving her home. A man reportedly confessed and admitted having killed the young woman by firearm. The man was supposedly her lover. The suspect's girlfriend was also placed in police custody.
