The prosecutor of Meaux said this afternoon that it was a very violent crime scene, as he talked about the quintuple homicide which took place yesterday in the town of Seine et Marne. A mother and her 4 children aged 9 months to 10 years old were found dead in their apartment. The main suspect, the thirty-year-old's partner, was arrested and taken into police custody this morning. He was known for acts of domestic violence and psychiatric disorders. An investigation was opened for "intentional homicide with premeditation".

And another shooting took place last night in Marseille. A man was shot dead in the district of Cabucelle in the 15th arrondissement. According to investigators, it was a settling of scores in relation to drug trafficking. This is the 48th shooting victim in Marseille since the start of the year.

Around fifty personalities from the world of culture have signed a column in Le Figaro to support the actor Gérard Depardieu and denounce his "lynching". Implicated in a documentary of Complément d'Enquête for sexist remarks, he is also indicted for rape. Nathalie Baye, Benoît Poelvoorde and Pierre Richard call for people not to play the role of justice.

An investigation has been opened after the discovery of the corpse of a wild boar hanging from the gate of a mosque in Essonne. An unpleasant surprise for the faithful of Vigneux sur Seine on Sunday morning. An Islamophobic act denounced by the cultural association of Muslims in the town. A complaint has been filed.

Also in the news, Alexei Navalny is ok. The main opponent of Vladimir Putin is in a penal colony in the Russian Arctic. As a reminder, his relatives have not heard from him for three weeks. The United States and France say they are deeply concerned about his conditions of detention.
