The father accused of having killed his wife and four children Monday evening in Meaux, in Seine-et-Marne has just been indicted for murder of a spouse and minors under the age of 15. In police custody, the 33-year-old man, already known for domestic violence has admitted to the crimes.

If he is judged responsible for his actions, he faces life in prison.

A hard blow for the employees of Habitat: The furniture brand was placed in liquidation by the Bobigny commercial court, due to its great financial difficulties. The company employs more than 300 employees in its 25 French stores. They intend to file a complaint against management.

The price of insurance will increase in 2025. The additional premium which finances the natural disaster regime of French insurers will increase from 12 to 20%, as the system has been in deficit since 2015. This increase will make it possible to raise more than an additional billion euros per year.
