Pas-de-Calais is still under red alert for floods. This morning 500 residents were still without electricity due to rising waters. According to the prefecture, more than 50 municipalities are affected in the department. Government spokesperson Olivier Véran and the Minister of Ecological Transition Christophe Béchu are on site to provide support for relief and disaster victims. Four departments are under orange alert for floods: the North, Aisne, Ardennes and Meuse.

Deportations of delinquent foreigners has increased by 30% last year in France, reaching nearly 4,700 people. This was announced by the Ministry of the Interior. Gérald Darmanin recalls that from the end of the month, the immigration law will make it possible to further considerably increase these deportations.

And inflation started to rise again in December, with an increase of 3.7% over one year – Mainly due to the rise in energy prices which reached more than 5%. The increase in prices, on the other hand, has continued to slow. A few weeks ago, the Minister of Economy, Bruno Le Maire, estimated that the inflationary crisis caused by the repercussions of Covid and then the war in Ukraine was behind us, even if the level of inflation will remain a little higher than before the crisis.

Maison Lejaby is placed in receivership. The decision was made by the Lyon commercial court at the request of the lingerie brand, in the grip of serious financial difficulties. The company based in Rillieux-La-Pape, near Lyon, employs 55 employees. At the beginning of the 2000s the brand still had a thousand employees. Unions will be vigilant about possible layoffs.

And to finish, Anthony Delon accuses his sister of having endangered their father. He filed a complaint against his sister Anouchka.
