The composition of the first government of Gabriel Attal should be announced this evening. The Prime Minister once again spoke with Emmanuel Macron this afternoon at the Elysée. It now seems certain that Gérald Darmanin will remain at the Ministry of the Interior. It remains to be seen what fate will be reserved for Bruno Le Maire at Bercy. According to the latest reports, he will remain at the Ministry of Economy, just like Éric Dupond-Moretti is expected to remain at the Ministry of justice.

Gatherings are organized today in front of the courts and prefectures, throughout France, in relation to the “case Gérard Depardieu”. Feminist associations denounce the support provided by Emmanuel Macron to the actor, targeted for rape and sexual assault. They call for demonstrations against the “sexist old world”.

Several theaters in the south of France are canceling performances by Philippe Caubère, as an investigation for sexual assault on a minor over 15 years old has been opened against the actor. He confirmed that a few years ago he had an intimate relationship for several months with a minor aged 16, when he was over 60.

And questions continue to be raised at the Nantes University Hospital, after the death of a patient on a stretcher, due to lack of space. The victim, aged 86, was in the emergency room for a case of Covid. Unions denounce the lack of beds and means.

It's an event for all American basketball fans: The NBA will be in Paris this evening for a regular season match at the Accor Arena between the Cleveland Cavaliers and the Brooklyn Nets. The game begins at 8 p.m. We already know that the NBA will be back in Paris next year, perhaps with Victor Wembanyama and the Spurs.

And then there are no longer any departments under orange snow and ice alert. Météo France has lifted the alert in Aude, Aveyron, Hérault and Tarn. On the other hand, Pas- de-Calais is still orange for floods.
