Many followed Emmanuel Macron's press conference last night: 8.7 million viewers according to Médiamétrie's report. The Head of State discussed for two hours the main axes of the rest of his five-year term. He made announcements about schools with the generalization of uniforms by 2026, about health, taxes, energy and even Ukraine. His policy takes a turn towards the Right which inspires a traditional France according to Bruno Cautres, Researcher at the CNRS and at the Sciences Po Political Research Center

Emmanuel Macron also wants to increase births, which have been declining for around ten years.

The objective for Rachida Dati is Paris. The newly appointed Minister of Culture stated this morning that she will be a candidate for the town hall of Paris in the 2026 municipal elections.

2 days after the passage of cyclone Belal, Gérald Darmanin is today in the Reunion Island to take stock of the damage and provide support to the victims, particularly to farmers. The Minister of the Interior and Overseas Territories announced that discussions will take place on Friday concerning a decree of a state of natural disaster.

And then almost 3 months after the Rugby World Cup and the elimination of the French XV in quarterfinals, Fabien Galthier revealed today the list of those who will start the 6 Nations Tournament. 34 players are selected with quite a few new ones: Emmanuel Meafou, Nicolas Depoortere and Matthias Halagahu. The XV de France which will begin its tournament in Marseille against Ireland on February 2.
