Difficult traffic conditions in the north of the country, due to the weather conditions, which have caused accidents and traffic jams on the main roads. More snow is expected tonight. 30 departments are placed under orange alert, including 25 for snow and ice. This concerns almost all of Normandy, Hauts-de-France, part of the Grand Est and the Paris region. The Prefect recommends that residents of Île de France return home before 7 p.m. tonight.

Return to calm in the Reunion Island, hit at the start of the week by cyclone Belal. Traveling to the island today, the Minister of the Interior and Overseas Territories Gérald Darmanin announced that the state recognition procedure of natural disaster will be declared at the very beginning of next week.

1 week after his departure from the government, Olivier Dussopt was acquitted by the courts today. The former Minister of Labor was tried for acts of favoritism during the attribution of a public water contract in 2009 when he was mayor of Annonay in Ardèche.

And perhaps a new twist in the case of Lina - The 15-year-old teenager who disappeared last September in a village in Bas-Rhin. 8 days after her disappearance, her ex-boyfriend died in a car accident after being caught driving at 185 km/h by the police who could not chase him. We do not know if the 22-year-old man wanted to avoid being stopped. For now, no link has been established between Lina's disappearance and this tragedy.

In Nancy, several CE2 students came across pornographic images while using one of the establishment's digital tablets. The firewall was reportedly deactivated. An internal administrative investigation was opened to find out how these images got there. A psychologist was summoned to the scene to speak with the children and parents also decided to file a complaint.
