Prime Minister Gabriel Attal is due to receive this evening at 6 p.m. the president of the FNSEA, Arnaud Rousseau - A meeting to try to appease the anger of farmers, as farmers have been demonstrating since last week, notably in the south of Toulouse and have been blocking the A64 Motorway since Thursday evening. Today they are waiting for real support from the State while their situation becomes more and more precarious.

Gabriel Attal also indicated that he will receive the president of the *Jeunes Agriculteurs*.

6 years after the events, the trial of the Trèbes and Carcassonne attacks opened this morning before the circuit court of Paris. These attacks caused four deaths, including Lieutenant-Colonel Arnaud Beltrame on March 23, 2018. 6 men and a woman are on trial for “criminal terrorist association”. They are relatives of the attacker Radouane Lakdim, who was killed during the GIGN assault. The trial will last 1 month.

The hiker who went missing yesterday at the Isola 2000 station in the Alpes-Maritimes, was found dead this morning by the gendarmes. A search unit was set up yesterday evening to try to find her, after she had left Snowshoeing alone.

And then a word of handball: Les Bleus face Austria today for the penultimate match of the Main Round of the Men's Euro. In the event of a victory, the French team may qualify this evening for the semi-finals. France-Austria, starts at 6 p.m.
