A woman in her thirties who was participating in the blocking the N20 in Pamiers in Ariège was killed this morning, hit by a car. Her 14-year-old daughter and her husband were seriously injured. The condition of the teenager is particularly concerning. The 3 people on board the vehicle involved were placed in police custody, but the circumstances of this tragedy still remain quite vague according to the prefect of Ariège Simon Bertoux who spoke a few minutes ago.

Although this seems to be an accident, the public prosecutor's office of Foix has opened an investigation.

Gérard Larcher is opposed to the inclusion of abortion in the Constitution. The President of the Senate considers that the Constitution "is not a catalog of social and societal rights". This measure will be debated tomorrow in the Assembly.
