Gabriel Attal brought together the Ministers of Agriculture, Ecological Transition and Economy this morning in Matignon to take note of the decisions which will be announced tomorrow by the Prime Minister regarding farmers. Gabriel Attal is expected to make a trip to go directly to the meeting of farmers mobilized in the region. Marine LePen stated this morning that the worst adversaries of farmers are in the government.

In the meantime, the pressure from the agricultural sector is not subsiding. Go slow operations and blockades have increased again today.

We also learned that an accident occurred last night at the blockade of north of Montauban, where two people were slightly injured after hitting a bale of straw on a blocked highway.

Also in the news, anti-Semitic acts have highly increased in France, particularly since the October 7 attacks against Israel. Their number has quadrupled in one year, according to the CRIF report published this morning. During the three months following the Hamas attacks there were as many anti-Semitic acts recorded as in the last three years combined. However, these figures reflect "only part" of anti-Semitic acts according to the CRIF: those which have been the subject of a complaint or a report to the police.

Soon the moment of truth for the Immigration law. The Constitutional Council is rendering its long-awaited decision this afternoon on the controversial text. Certain measures may be censored, such as changing access to social benefits for foreigners. The opponents plan to gather in several cities, notably in Paris near the Constitutional Council.

And then the Solidarity Night returns for a 7th edition this evening in Paris and in several municipalities in Île-de-France. Organized since 2018, the operation consists of counting the number of homeless people. There were more than 3,000 in the capital in 2023, which is an increase of 16% compared to 2022.
