3 weeks after his arrival in Matignon, Gabriel Attal is expected at the National Assembly this afternoon. The Prime Minister will deliver his general policy speech and will speak at 3 p.m. in front of the MPs to set the course of his new government.

And the successor to Elisabeth Borne will also discuss the current crisis in the agricultural sector, however without making new concrete announcements to try to get out of it. Farmers remain mobilized: several blockades are still in place on the highways around Paris. The convoy of nearly 200 tractors, which left Lot et Garonne yesterday, resumed its route towards the Capital with the objective of reaching the market of Rungis. The convoy was stopped after Limoges this morning by the police.

And member of the police force had mobilized mid-January to get answers concerning the Olympics this summer, and they were heard. The Minister of the Interior announced this morning a bonus for all agents involved in the preparation or the progress of the Olympic Games. The bonuses will go from 1000 to 1900 euros. In a letter, Gerald Darmanin also provides details on the question of leave during this period, and on aid to enable them to provide for childcare during their absences.

In Marseille, an investigation is underway after a fire last night in a building, which killed a child. A dozen people are also injured, including 4 children aged 4 to 13, who were evacuated in absolute emergency. We do not yet know the reasons for this fire.
