Emmanuel Macron will be meeting with farmers' unions for the first time since the industrial action started. The President will meet with the Rural Coordination and Countryside Alliance tomorrow and the FNSEA and Young Farmers' unions next week. These discussions come ahead of the traditional Agricultural Show which is scheduled at the end of the month. This afternoon, Gabriel Attal will meet with the FNSEA and the Young Farmers.

Searches have been ongoing since Sunday for a missing teenager in Deux Sèvres. 18-year-old Erwan has not been heard from since Saturday night. He was last seen leaving a nightclub in Moncoutant-sur-Sèvre.

Representatives from the Républicains party are seeking to reopen the debate on the new immigration law. To do so, they need the support of 185 members of parliament and the approval of the constitutional council. Then, a Shared Initiative referendum could be held, focusing on the measures challenged by the constitutional council.

The scheme for leasing electric cars has just come to an end, as 50,000 households took advantage of it, which was twice as many as expected. The scheme allowed subscribers to use an electric vehicle for 100 euros per month. It will be made available again in 2025.

And finally, Julia Simon will be going after her fourth medal at the Biathlon World Championships today. The athlete from the Savoie will be taking part in the individual event at 5:10 pm this afternoon. French athletes Justine Braiza Bouché and Lou Jeannmonnot will also be hoping for a spot on the podium.
